

Sweden has introduced registration and tuition fees for citizens outside the EU, EEA countries and Switzerland. Fees must be paid when registering for courses on basic and advanced levels that start after 31 July 2011.

Registration fee for students outside EU / EEA

A registration fee of 900 Swedish kronor be notified to the education of undergraduate and graduate levels. The registration fee paid by applicants who are not citizens of EU, EEA or Switzerland, and will apply to studies that begin autumn term of 2011.

Tuition fees for students outside EU / EEA

Tuition fees will be made for applicants who have been admitted to training in basic and advanced levels that start after 31 July 2011. Course fees paid by applicants who are not nationals of an EU Member State, EEA country or Switzerland and are paid directly to the university that the applicant will be studying at. Course fee is determined by each university, which also administers the payment. The fee, payable each term, must be paid before the student begins / continues his studies at the university.

Exceptions

Certain exemptions from the requirement to pay registration and / or study fees are, however, for example if you:

- have a permanent residence permit in Sweden
- has a temporary residence permit in Sweden for reasons other than study
- a family member of a national of an EU / EEA country who have right of residence or permanent residence status in Sweden
- a family member of a Swiss citizen and holds a residence permit in Sweden
- have long-term status in Sweden
- have long-term status in another EU / EEA country and have residence permits in Sweden
- is a student at a university abroad but carry a small part of your education at a Swedish university under an exchange agreement whereby study fee is not charged by the host

- studying in the context of such an exchange study fee as decided by the Government not to be charged for.

- You do not pay the registration fee if you are registered on a course at a Swedish university of payment. It has the right to terminate their education (course or program) without paying the fee for the study.
